a. Quiz Format-

- a. A written MCQ based paper pencil test of 50 questions divided in different topics.
- b. Top 10 from each team will be informed to the coordinators. These 10 participants will represent the team for further rounds
- C. Participants can also be asked to write an essay which can be used as a tie breaker if needed. We can also give special mention to any extraordinary essay, if any.

b. Exam Centers-

- a. With 16 teams, qualifying test can be conducted at approximately 4 exam centres close to every 3 teams (area wise).
- Alternatively, we can arrange for the exam at Nappoo Hall on one day at 1 or 2 different timings and accommodate all the participants (all participants have to come to one venue)

c. Exam Rules-

- a. Minimum participants required in each team 20
- b. If any team has less than 20 participants, they will be merged with another team.
- c. Each participant must be of 7th, 8th and 9th Standard only
- d. All question papers for eliminations in the Quiz will be provided by the DDKF QC Organising Committee.
- e. No conferring will be allowed between participants during writing the paper pencil test.
- f. After scoring is done, top 10 participants from each team will be announced. We have an OMR sheet scanner and a software to analyze and score the sheets.

d. Semi Finals & Finals-

- a. These top 10 participants will come for the Semi Finals followed by finals
- b. The semi finals & finals will be conducted in a separate room with zero access to parents, guests and any other individual except for those involved with the logistic planning of the event.
- c. For all others, the event will be telecasted live in another room where all can participate and DDKF Committee can interact with the parents/ guests and other invitees.
- d. Incase of a tie, the grading will be done by DDKF and the result will be DDKF prerogative
- e. Final decision will be taken by the DDKF committee and the Quiz Master.
- f. After the finals, award ceremony will be held immediately at the venue, bringing closure to the event

e. Prizes-

- a. One trophy to be given to the winning team
- b. There will be 3 top winners
- c. All participants will be felicitated with a certificate/ award
